



# Khan Bahadur Hassanally Effendi


Khan Bahadur Hassanally Effendi was an educationist, visionary, and one of the towering personalities of the subcontinent. He established Sindh Madressatul Islam School in 1885 where most of the leadership for Pakistan movement graduated, including the Founder of the Nation, Quaid-e-Azam Mohammad Ali Jinnah.

Mr. Effendi was born on 14th August 1830 in an Akhund family from Hyderabad. His father died when he was very young and was reared by his elder brother Umed Ali Akhund. He was sent to a local Madressah to study Quran and Persian Language. After completing his basic education, he was appointed as Clerk in the Office of Deputy Collector. Young Effendi was inspired by the Western education, so to acquire Western knowledge he used his leisure time learning English language. Later he joined the Indus Flotilla, a shipping company, where Mr. Effendi met a British Judge, Mr. Middleton, who was so impressed with his English language skills that he even offered him a job of translator in Karachi District Court. Because it was very rare for a Muslim taking interest in English language and Western education. He gladly accepted the offer and shifted to Karachi.

Mr. Effendi was very dedicated and passionate about his job. He acquainted himself with the legal system and laws so much so that he even started giving advices to the people on legal matters. His thirst for knowledge and acute understanding of law shook Judge Middleton to the extent that he even allowed him to practice law without any formal law degree. This proved to be a turning point for Mr. Effendi because he turned out to be the only Muslim advocate in the entire region among others, who either were English or Hindus. He was later appointed on the post of Public Prosecutor which he held for almost fourteen years.

Now, a well-established Mr. Effendi devoted himself for social, political and economic development of Muslims. He was inspired from Sir Syed Ahmed Khan who founded Aligarh Muslim University and Justice Ameer Ali Syed of Calcutta, a jurist and a Muslim political philosopher. So, he established Sindh Madressatul Islam (SMI) in Karachi in 1885. His services for the cause of education were appreciated by the British authorities and he was bestowed with the title of "Khan Bahadur". Not only that, during Russian war with Turkey, Mr. Effendi campaigned to collect funds and other items of aid for the Turkish brethren. The then Turkish Sultan, Abdul Hamid, highly valued his efforts and conferred upon him two Turkish titles "Bey" and "Effendi".

Although, Khan Bahadur Hassanally Effendi died in in 1895, just after ten years of establishment of SMI School but under his supervision the environment of Sindh Madressatul Islam was so inspiring, conducive and encouraging that it produced the greatest leaders of all the times in the history of United India, which later resulted in creation of Pakistan. He shall always with us in the shape of SMI University.





The Sindh Madressatul Islam University is one of the oldest institutions in South Asia. The Founder of Pakistan, Quaid-e-Azam Mohammad Ali Jinnah, studied in this institution for about four and half years, from 1887-92, which is the longest period of his academic life. During the life span of 136 years, the institution has produced the greatest personalities in the history of the subcontinent who later played a pivotal role in the independence of Pakistan. The institution started as school in 1885, later as college in 1943, and was elevated to the level of a university in 2012.

Apart from its rich history, today, Sindh Madressatul Islam University (SMIU) is considered one of the top class universities of Pakistan, imparting quality education to every strata of the society. The university is privileged to have PhD and M.Phil. faculty members from the best national and international universities. It has the state-of-the-art equipment, air condition classrooms and auditorium with SMD Wall, it has its own FM Radio Station, TV Studio, computer laboratories with latest computer machines, cafeteria, gymnasium, Media Training Center, high speed internet, multimedia projectors, medical unit, e-resources, digital library, and central library. The university's library has more than fifteen thousand books, some of which are rare ones. It also subscribes to about

three dozen national and international research journals in

addition to Higher Education Commission's (HEC) sponsored

digital access to most reputed international journals. SMIU

continuously strives to improve its facilities with cutting edge

The university has Jinnah Museum which contains the relics associated with the founder of the institution, Khan Bahadur Hassanally Effendi, as well as educational records of Quaid-e-Azam Mohammad Ali Jinnah and other alumni.

Since SMIU started as school, so the university authorities decided to continue its legacy. The SMIU Model School houses around 1200 children of underprivileged class society who acquire A and O level education on very nominal fee.


SMIU currently offers BS, MS, MBA, and PhD. Programs in ten market driven departments. i.e. Artificial Intelligence and Mathematical Sciences, Accounting, Banking and Finance, Business Administration, Computer Science, Software Engineering, Media and Communication Studies, Environmental Sciences, Social Development, Education, and English.

The university has recently constructed state-of-the-art Information Technology Tower at the city campus which houses Departments of Artificial Intelligence and Mathematical Sciences, Software Engineering, and Computer Sciences. The I.T. Tower has highly sophisticated equipment to meet the needs of modern day generation.

In addition to these facilities at its main campus, the university's Malir campus in Education City is under construction on 100 acres of land. The federal government has approved project to the tune of 1.75 billion. Along with these two campuses, SMIU also have 10 acres of land in Hawksbay Area. The provincial government has been approached to approve a development scheme for SMIU's Hawksbay campus. When all three campuses functional, SMIU shall have capacity of imparting education to around forty thousand students.

A research proposal is a document proposing a research project in academia. Proposals are evaluated on the cost and potential impact of the proposed research, and on the soundness of the proposed plan for carrying it out. Research proposals address several key points such as, what research question(s) will be addressed? how they will be addressed. How much time and expense? will be required for the research? and what prior research has been done on the topic. Therefore, a research proposal needs to be good as one's research.

In this context, a live webinar on the topic "How to write a good thesis research proposal" was organized by department of computer Science, Sindh Madresatul islam university, Karachi on 26th December 2020, with an aim to guide and help MS/M.Phil and Ph.D level students for writing their thesis research proposals.

Guest speaker, Prof. Dr. Asadullah Shah, who is distinguish professor of Information and communication technologies at International Islamic University Malaysia, highlighted the importance of research, research proposal, and thoroughly explained the research cycle as well as steps involved in writing a good thesis research proposal. Forty students participated for the activity from which four teams consisting of ten members were constituted for a debate competition. Hingol National Park is in the Makran coastal

region and is the largest national park in Pakistan. The park's name is after the Southern part of the Hangul River which flows along the shores of Arabian Sea. Hingul national park contains six distinct eco-system including both deserts and plains regions, making it unique among the Pakistan's national park.

**Kund Malir Beach** in Baluchistan is about 150 kilometers from zero-point on Makran coastal highway. It is one of the most beautiful beaches in the world hence making itself one of the favorite places for tourist and locals.

#### 1st Webinar on Status of Social Sciences **Education in Pakistan and Need of Social Scientists in Society November, 2020**

#### CHILD LABOUR IN PAKISTAN: ISSUES, CHALLENGES AND REMEDIES

A webinar on "Child Labour in Pakistan: Issues, Challenges and Remedies" was organized on 18th June, 2021 by the Department of Social Development, Sindh Madressatul Islam University, Karachi. Prof. Dr. Farhan Essa, (CEO of Essa Laboratory), Dr. Jaipal Chhabria (Secretary Human Rights Committee of Pakistan Medical Association (PMA), Karachi and member of National Commission for Minorities) and Dr. Subhash (Associate Professor, Department of Social Development, SMIU, Karachi) were the speakers of the session. Webinar was moderated by Mr. Muhammad Kamil Lakho, Lecturer,



Department of Social Development. The webinar was attended by faculty members and large number of the students of SMIU, Karachi through Zoom online.

Mr. Lakho started the webinar with shedding light on the issue of child labour in Pakistan and related issues in the society. Later he introduced guest speakers in the session and invited them to talk on the topic. First, Dr. Farhan Esa briefed on the nature of child labour and current status of child labour in Pakistan. Dr. Farhan told that this was very important social problem in the society and millions of children were engaged in the unlawful work all over the country. He told participants that children were facing many physical and health issues due to labour.

Dr. Jaipal talked in detail on the topic and explained the government policies and laws about child labour in the world and Pakistan. He lamented that although child rights were recognized by the government but overall the situation was not satisfactory. In that context he mentioned different challenges and obstacles to curb the child labour in Pakistan.

#### **IMPORTANCE OF VACCINES IN CURRENT SITUATION**

A webinar titled, "Importance of Vaccines in Current Situation" was organized today on 30th April, 2021 by the Department of Social



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Development, Sindh Madressatul Islam University, Karachi. Project Director EPI, Government of Sindh, and other public health experts briefed on the vaccination status and highlighted the challenges in the immunization. The webinar was attended by faculty members, students of SMIU, and other universities of Sindh. Whereas, Webinar was moderated by Dr. Subhash, Associate Professor, Department of Social Development, SMIU, Karachi.

Dr. Muhammad Juman Bahoto, PD, EPI elaborated the role played by the EPI in the vaccination process and generated immunity among the children and people of Sindh. Furthermore, Dr. Ahsan Bhurgri (Technical Advisor EPI) explained the immunization and vaccination, and how EPI Sindh was reaching the defined goals. A detailed presentation describing which diseases were especially prevailing among the children of Sindh province and to which EPI was meeting through the vaccination was given by Mr. Sunil Raja (Communication Specialist EPI / UNICEF).





## Title of a Book: **Phonetics and Cognitive Linguistics** in **Pakistani English (Pinglish)**

This book of Linguistics is based on the collection of carefully chosen quality research studies in the fields of Experimental Phonetics and Cognitive Linguistics coupled with English Language Teaching & Learning aspects. The entire study is an offshoot of two doctoral dissertations i.e., two broad fields in Linguistics to enlighten the minds of the students of Linguistics in Pakistan. It begins with experimental phonetics through Cognitive to Meta-cognitive strategies in reading comprehension; followed by

speech anxiety factors of second language learning and its impact on the performance of second language learners.

Inaddition, the book has been divided into 8 chapters. Chapters 1-3 contain phonetic & phonological aspects of American Sindhi Word Stress, elements of phonological aspects & the perceptual study of phonological variations in Pinglish (PaKE). Chapters 4-5 are founded on the meta-cognitive strategies used in reading comprehension. Chapters 6-8 contain English communication skills of university students, speech anxiety aspects in terms of learning, social and academic impact on second language learning, writing and Teaching Methods in ELT. This compact book further spells out the conceptual understanding of Linguistics in the Pakistani context which will surely be helpful for the students of linguistics from BS/MS English Linguistics to Ph.D. Linguistics.


The letters were distributed among eighteen [18] employees who were upgraded to the next grades.

#### **SMIU Employees Participate in Training Office Management Skills**




To be a leading finance service provider offering the highest level of service to university consistent with the international standards and regulatory quidelines.


their results outstanding in their semester. Need based scholarship was provided by HEC at constant rate every year whereas the Merit based was flexible depending on the availability of resources.






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### Khan Bahadur Hassanally Effendi Library

The KBHE Library was established in 2012 with SMI's elevation to the level of a university. The library aims to support faculty, students and administration. It also aims to expand library resources physically form as well as digitally. The library strives to enhance students learning experience by providing conducive environment. It has made its digital resources available on the fingertips of its users through online. The digital resources can be accessed form home 24/7 by students and faculty members. The library has about 350,000 volume/ documents including 19000 books, subscription of 34 scholarly journals, 08 Magazines, HEC digital library and a huge collection of e-books. Collection consists of textbooks and reference books of compulsory & elective courses all departments.

#### **Progress**

The library adopted slogan "Beyond Physical Books" at the onset of COVID-19 pandemic which forced all institutions to shift from physical on online education. To prevent the academic loss of students in SMI University shifted almost all library resources into digital form. The university started providing even more robust online learning resources and worked to get e-subscriptions to the users.

The library continuously displayed upward trends in terms of reading materials and provided congenial environment, prompt and courteous services to meet the needs of the students and faculty members. The following glimpses speak volume of the efforts made by the library for the students and academia.

#### Collection

The library maintains the vast collection of books and periodicals. In the year 2020-21, the HEC provided support to cope up with the emergent COVID-19 financial challenges to the public sector universities. An amount of Rs.358,000 was released to SMI University library under the "Library support program" for purchase of books & subscription of research journals.















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### Admission and Examination Department

Fall 2020 semester was affected by Covid-19 restrictions, due to which instead of Midterm Examinations, Continuous Assessment was introduced as a matter of evaluation of students' academic performance. Final terms examinations were held Online and multiple evaluation methods, including but not limited to Quizzes, Assignment, reports and presentations were adopted as alternatives to physical examinations for Spring 2021, approx. 2900 students got themselves enrolled for the semesters. Usual assessment methods were restored and On-Campus exams were held for both Midterms and Finals. Both of the Exams were held with strict adherence to Covid-19 SOPs.

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




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### **Accreditation Quality Enhancement Cell**

Quality Enhancement in higher education is a process of building stakeholders' confidence that fulfils expectations as well as minimum requirements of education, learning and research. Quality assurance is the term covering all the policies, processes, procedures and actions through which quality of higher education is not simply maintained, but developed and enhanced. Although quality assurance in higher education is a global challenge which demands improving the quality of higher education on viable and sustainable basis the gaps in various aspects of educational quality demand an intensely focused approach to assure/ enhance the quality of education as well as research in the universities.

Although some of the Pakistani universities are performing well and are included in the top universities of the world but quality of higher education in Pakistan, in general, does not meet international standards. Realizing the needs to improve the lot of Higher Education in the country, Higher Education Commission of Pakistan established Quality Assurance Agency (QAA) in 2005 as a policy making and monitoring body for maintenance and enhancement of quality in higher education. National Quality Assurance Committee has been formed as advisory body to the specialties and senior academic managers. The Agency is engaged in systematic implementation of quality enhancement procedures/criteria to attain improved levels of international compatibility and competitiveness at institutional and program level. Furthermore, Quality Enhancement Cells (QECs) have been established in many public sector and private sector universities.

Sindh Madressatul Islam University has established a full-fledged Quality Enhancement Cell which is completed after induction of its Director and allied staff. Quality education has always been the prime priority of SMI University. The university

management ensures quality in every dimension and in every manner whether it is to provide infrastructure and ancillary facilities to students or to develop intellect in them.

QAA Pakistan has devised a three-tier quality assurance mechanism. At the first step, selfassessment (SA) of programs is required to be conducted annually. Secondly, university are required to carry out an internal audit after every two years and at the third step that is to be followed by an external review on four yearly bases.


Self-assessment is an exercise conducted by the institution/department itself to assess whether its programs meet their educational objectives and outcomes with the purpose to improve quality of programs and enhance students' learning. Self-Assessment is documented as Self-Assessment Report (SAR) which makes the basis of all future audits and reviews. Self-Assessment is carried out with certain objectives and institutional goals, provision of feedback for quality assurance of academics.

#### **Achievements**

The Accreditation Quality Enhancement Cell of Sindh Madressatul Islam University accomplished excellent performance award by the Quality Assurance Agency HEC. This award was presented to Director AQEC in the annual progress meeting of the QAA. Quality enhancement is a continuous process of the actions with the coordination of university's stakeholders and QEC team.



# Participation in QEC Workshop organized by PAF-KIET






### Office of Research, Innovation & Commercialization

The ORIC provides strategic and operational support to university's research activities and programs. It has the pivotal role in facilitating the university's research focusing mainly on transformation of invention (pure knowledge/ideas) into innovation (products and production processes) which ultimately leads to commercialization thus, creating a significant impact on the community welfare as a whole.

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#### **ORIC consists of three important wings:**

- a. Research Development and Operation
- b. Innovation
- c. Research Commercialization/Entrepreneurship. The role and function of each section under the umbrella of ORIC are defined as under:

A) Research Development and Operations: This wing aims to develop research culture at SMI University by introducing various research opportunities to faculty/researchers of SMIU. It also facilitates in the external and internal sponsored

opportunities to faculty/researchers of SMIU. It also facilitates in the external and internal sponsored projects of the institution by providing pre and post award support to PIs. It supports faculty with grant proposal submissions in conjunction with Sponsored Projects Administration (budget development, award documentation, administrative portions of proposals, internal approvals, monitor issues around effort, cost share, space needs, and tuition remission). It also coordinates with all concerned offices/departments for the activities focused on research at the institution.

- **B) Innovation:** The innovative programs are integral to any institution. This wing continuously strives to develop innovative ideas and assess their feasibility for further implementation to ensure sustainable growth of the institution. In this domain, many innovative ideas have been materialized such as leadership programs, online certification programs, preparatory classes, leadership courses, new opportunities for funded projects as well as outreach and national hunt programs.
- **C)** Research Commercialization: ORIC is incomplete without the vision to make institution a powerhouse of innovation. This wing has the grand role to inculcate and promote entrepreneurship, technology-transfer and commercialization

activities among researchers and scholars. This is done to energize and support the local and national economy and to help startups to incubate, grow, create new jobs, products, services, markets, carry out innovation and bring in funding.

# Practical Media Training for SMIU Students



#### **SMIUTV**

SMIU TV Studio serves as practical lab for SMIU Media Studies Students as well as this professional Studio is also utilized for broadcast programming of HEC EduTV, Under the MoU MTC provides weekly transmission to HEC EduTV.

Another milestone achieved by MTC Directorate as SMIU WebTV has started its test transmission on 18th July 2020 by utilizing the existing resources and equipment already placed in SMIU TV Studio which was earlier used as a media lab, now it is utilized as professional production studio. It is utilized as practical platform for students to learn online content creation and other media skills considering this fact the whole content of SMIU WebTV is produced by the students of SMIU with supervision and guidance of MTC Officials/Trainers, MTC through its broadcasting also play its role as buffer between industry and academia where students meet the professionals in studios while conducting the broadcast programs.

#### **Public Awareness Program**





#### **Information Technology Block**

- The Information Technology Block is a ground plus 6 storey building and it covers area of approximately 38500 sq.ft.
- The building is designed in conformity with historic architectural tradition of SMIU. In near future, the construction of I.T block will be completed and furnished for the upcoming sessions.

#### **Construction of K-Electric Substation** (884 KW)

- Electric load of SMI University was 375 Kilo Watts against total capacity of 400 kilo watts, without accounting load of new SMIU Model School and IT Block.
- Electric load of new SMIU Model School and IT Block was estimated to be around 484 Kilo Watts which could not be supported on existing PMT.
- Hence, in order to meet Electric load requirements, substation for the capacity of 884 Kilo watts was initiated and completed successfully.

#### **Old Model School into a New Cafeteria and University Block**

The ground floor of old SMIU Model School was converted into new cafeteria to serve around 300 students and staff members. While the 1st floor of the old Model School building was converted into University Block for classes of different departments.





### Directorate of Public Relations & Publications

#### Introduction:

The Directorate of Public Relations and Publications deals with all kinds of relations especially with media organizations and their staff, students who approach through different Social Media sites. The staff regularly updates all kinds of activities of the university and SMIU Model School students, faculty and staff.

As the mouthpiece of the university, Directorate of PR disseminate all kinds of public and students' interests related information through various means, including Social Media, TV, Print, Electronic and Digital Media.

The Directorate issues all statements and information shared by the offices of Controller of Examination, DSA, ORIC, Registrar and others in the best interests of the university students from time to time.

It also covers all events, programs, seminars, workshops, conferences, sports and extra-curricular activities and university activities where the worthy Vice Chancellor of the university appears as the guest.

A few major component of the PR Directorate: There are different activities the PR Directorate is involved and engaged since its inception which include:

#### **Mainstream Media:**

The PR Directorate keeps the ties with all media outlets and their staff intact in the best interests of the university including SMIU Model School and their students, Faculty and staff. For publication of news and better relations, the staff usually visit their offices, Press Club/s, their events and their homes at some occasions for frequent interactions.

#### **VC Secretariat:**

To keep abreast of daily engagements, assignments and events, the PR Directorate staff remains in contact with the VC Secretariat and disseminate information to the general public when and where necessary after the approval.

#### **Social Media/Website:**

Owing to growing importance and outreach of the Social Media, the PR Directorate maintains and updates all Social Media sites of the university, including Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, etc. It also remains in contact with university's Website team to share details of regular activities related to admission, students and faculty activities.

Recently, with the efforts of the Directorate of PR, university's official Twitter account has been verified. It is pertinent to mention here that, SMIU is one a few public & private universities in Pakistan that is verified Twitter account. We run paid campaign on social media channels to promote our activities and get desired result from our campaign.

#### **Students:**

The major chunk of the new admission each semester comes through Social Media sites. So, the students prefer to get all kinds of information from Social Media pages instead of reading national newspaper where Admission/Convocation Advertisements are published. The students frequently ask questions/information from time to time and mostly enrolled students' first choice is to get speedy information from Social Media Sites and Chats instead of writing emails and phoning to concerned department. Students and their parents also contact the

Students and their parents also contact the university administration through emails @info which the PR Directorate regulates.

#### **Controller of Examination:**

There is a strong link between the Directorate of PR and the Admission Office. From publishing advertisements in newspapers to disseminating information to students and their parents, PR Directorate remains in constant contact with the Admission Office. Due to paid campaign on social media the candidates who applying for admissions were increasing as compare to previous years.

### Directorate of Students Affairs & Counselling:

The DSA and PR Directorate with mutually understanding share and spread information with the general public/students through Social Media pages and Press Release.

#### **ORIC:**

PR Directorate remains in constant contact with ORIC officials and facilitates them in spreading information to different partners through national media and Social Media. PR Directorate also issues most of their Press Releases amongst the journalists.

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#### **Publication:**

The Directorate of PR frequently releases Press Release, Video Footages and Tickers to Print, Electronic and Digital Media regularly and also provides information to individual [journalists] when and where necessary. It also helps and facilitates media persons required information for their news stories and news packages.

Apart from linking with the national media, PR Directorate also helps and facilitates in printing and publishing various publications, including Banners, Pamphlets, Chronicles, Books, Brochure, Catalogs etc. from time to time in collaboration with different departments.

#### **SMIU Model School:**

PR Directorate also facilitates better relationship between SMIU Model School and media persons. It also spreads general information to students and parents related to new admissions and policies using different means of communication such as national media and Social Media sites.

#### **Sindh Information Department:**

For smooth and strong relations with Sindh Government's Information Departments, PR Directorate staff frequently remains in contact with top officials of SID. Owing to better ties, the advertisements of the university are published in different newspapers timely and visibly without any trouble and delay.

#### **Public Dealing – Image Building:**

To make a better image of the university, its faculty, students and staff, the PR Directorate keeps struggling to spread positive information through different means and tries its best to avoid any misinformation and fake news that could damage university's image in the public, government and among other universities.





#### **ADMINISTRATION RESPONSIBILITIES/ ACTIVITIES / DETAILS (From July 2020 to June** 2021)

SMIU Model School is a subsidiary of Sindh Madressatul Islam University. There are three sections in school: Primary section (grade I to V), Secondary section (grade VI to X) and Higher Secondary section (grade XI-XII)

Strength of Students: 750

#### Teachers: 39 (01 Principal, 01 Vice Principal, 01 Computer Instructor, 01 Librarian)

The school is operating three boards concurrently: Karachi Board for Secondary Education, Aga Khan Board for Secondary Education and Board of Intermediate Education, Karachi. The school management has been working hard to impart quality education to its vicinity.

The academic session 2020-21 was not as effective as compare to the previous ones. Less activities took place due to suspension of physical classes regarding COVID-19 Pandemic. However, SMIU Model School continued the Teaching/learning process through digital resources.

#### A shift to Digital Learning was brought together from Physical classes:

To cope up with the challenges brought up by continuous suspension of formal classes during COVID-19 lockdowns, School management brought a shift to Online Learning.

Online classes were arranged from grade I to XII, using various platforms like Google class rooms, Zoom app and whatsapp. Regular monitoring of the system was scheduled on weekly basis. Management conducted online meetings of all staff (through ZOOM application) to discuss the operations and the process. Though, the teachers and the management faced problems because of less privileged families under aspect of digital technologies.

# Affiliation of SMIU MODEL SCHOOL to Intermediate Board, Karachi as a Higher Secondary School:

A Team from Intermediate Board visited the school during COVID-19 lockdown and took interviews of the teachers and other related staff. The team examined all the required facilities and showed their satisfaction. The meeting was a success and SMIU Model School was awarded registration to the board for a period of three years.

#### **New Admissions for grades I to IX and XI:**

Registration of classes from I to IX started in September 2020, was followed by Admissions. While, Registration of students in Higher Secondary School started in August 2020. In September admissions were completed.

The School management facilitated the parents during lockdown period and managed provision of relevant staff and facilities following the COVID-19 SOPSs.

#### **School Management Committee (SMC):**

The competent authority formed a School Management Committee (SMC), to advance the then-in-practice processes. The members of the committee includes: The registrar from SMI University, 01 member from Admission department, 01 member from HRM, 02 members from finance department and 02 members (Principal and Vice Principal) from SMIU Model School.

Through the School Management Committee, a prominent help in multiple operations is comprehended.

# Aga Khan University Examination Board's Registration:

Aga Khan Examination Board requires a yearly renewal of every school to the board. The School got its affiliation to the board. Opening new horizons of opportunity to its students, and with the approval of Competent Authority, the School Management introduced 'Computer Science' as an Elective Subject to IX AKU-EB.

#### **Hippo English Language Contest:**

English Language is an International language to communicate. Considering the need of time









the school enrolled its students in Hippo - An International Language Contest. English Language Teachers assisted students to get an improved experience of English Language. Special classes held.

60 students represented SMIU Model School in the contest and results were remarkable. Our students stated the event as very informative and helpful.

## International Kangaroo Mathematics Contest:

Topolishmathematicalskillsinstudents, management registered 85 participants in international Contest of Mathematics –IKMC. The School has been taking participation in this contest since 2016. Through the help of our dedicated teachers our students have been achieving remarkable positions. This year, we got a Gold medal for the Principal, a Silver Medal for the coordinator and 5 Bronze Medals for students. Except medals our all students have received certificates and other gifts too.

# Home Exam and Preparation of Board Examination 2020

Examinations play an important role in assessment of learning. The school management took every possible effort to provide accessibility to learning resources. To assess effort by Teachers and Students both a home examination was taken.

For Classes I and II, an examination of specific subjects was taken. Similarly, for Classes III to X a midterm exam of reduced syllabus was taken.

Classes of grade IX and X held regularly. Our teachers worked hard to prepare students of IX and X grades from both Karachi Board and Aga Khan Board.











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
